Sounds - Consonants

- Initial consonants:

- de, te, ne, le → top front teeth
- ge, ke, he → throat
- ji, qi, xi → palatal
(back of the tongue arches upward)
- zhi, chi, shi, ri → retroflex
(tongue curled back)
- zi, ci, si → dental sibilant






Four Tones
